4. First Aid Measures (Actions)

Eye Contact:	In case of contact, rinse immediately with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists
Ingestion:	Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Wash out mouth with water and give copious amounts of water to drink. Do not induce vomiting. Obtain medical attention
Additional Information:	Always launder contaminated clothing before re-use

5. Fire Fighting Methods

Extinguishing	Does not in itself represent a fire hazard.
Media:	Water spray, foam sand, dry powder, or CO ₂

Fire Fighting Protective: Full protective equipment including suitable respiratory protection

Caution:	Spillages/burst containers could prove slippery Absorb spillage with sand or absorbent Transfer to a suitable container for disposal Dispose of under Local Authority Guidelines Small spillage flush away with water Avoid washings entering water courses
